- Recruit new workers for short and long-term service with Pioneers.
- Work with Mobilization Team to develop and implement a communications strategy for connecting with potential workers.
- Assist Communications Coordinator with digital media content related to mobilization.
- Attend Candidate Orientation week to grow in understanding Pioneers and the Mobilization Process.
- Actively grow in understanding of global missions.
- Support the Mobilization Team with other duties as needed or requested.
